REPORTS:

- 1. It was voted on and passed that the meeting place and dates for The Sun Lakes Camera Club will change for the 23-24 year. With proceeds divided equally between the club and a local non-profit. A committee would be needed to undertake this project. The membership will be asked for their interest and if they would be willing to serve on the committee.
- 5. It was suggested that it may be a good idea at this time to move \$5,000. of the club's funds to a high-yield, short term CD or TBill. Bob Little and Betsy Ohlgart will look into this.
- 6. The club's members will be asked for suggestions for summer photo op trips both locally and farther away.
- 7. The agenda for the April 6th meeting was set. John Livoti will present awards from the recent ACCC Spring Roundup. There will be a mock judging competition consisting of 3 seasoned judges and 3 random club members in which marks and comments will be compared in order to give everyone a better understanding of the judging process. Linda Davis has gathered a number of prints to be judged. This should be a fun experience.
